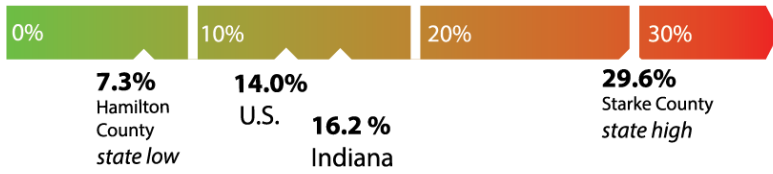


# The state of tobacco control in Gibson County

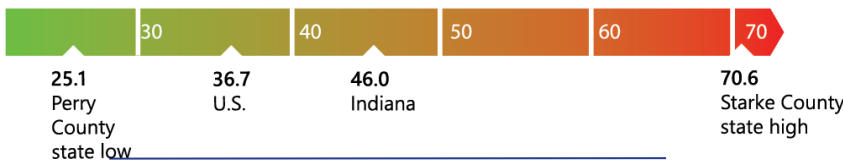
There is no tobacco control grant in Gibson County for 2023-2025.

## Tobacco and Health in Gibson County

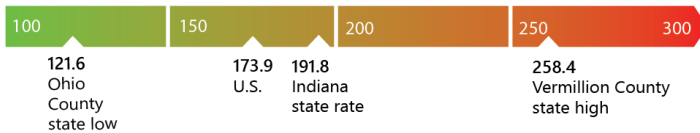
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **17.7%**



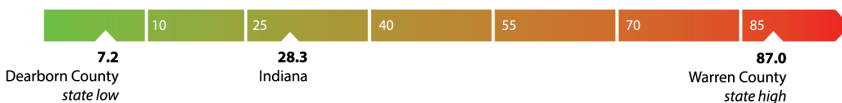
 **Lung cancer deaths** **42.1**
