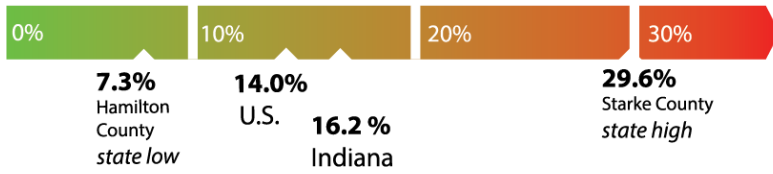


The state of tobacco control in Henry County

Tobacco and Health in Henry County

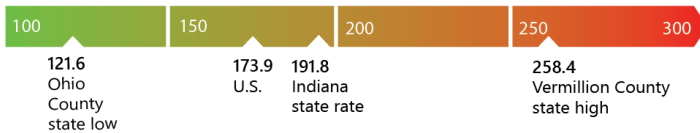
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **24.5%**



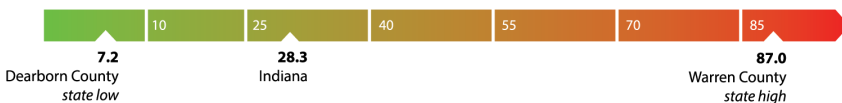
 **Lung cancer deaths** **55.4**
