

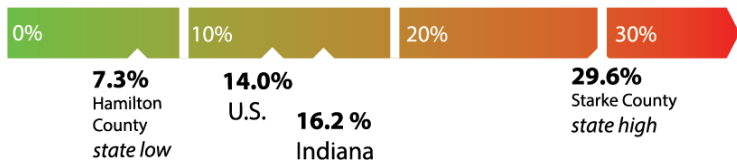

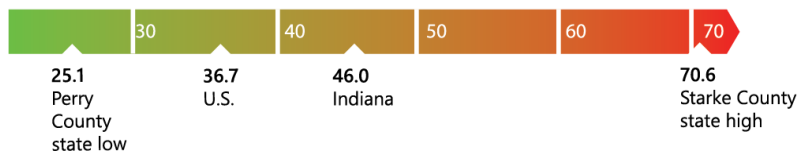

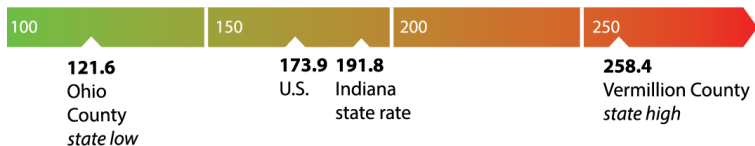
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **25.9%**



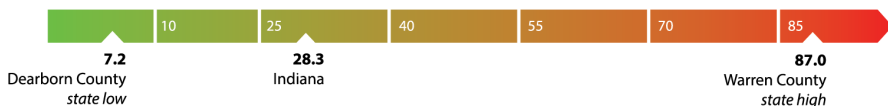
 **Lung cancer deaths** **45.7**
