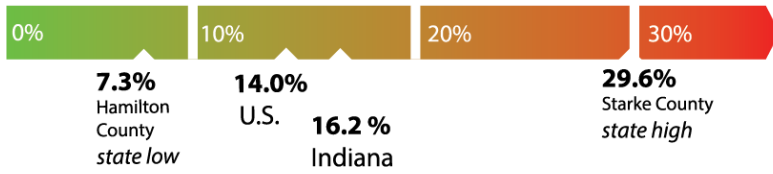


The state of tobacco control in Jasper County

Tobacco and Health in Jasper County

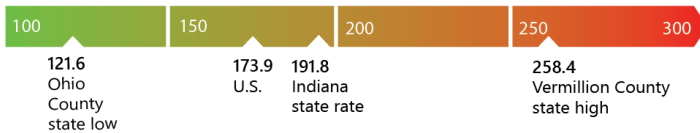
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **20.0%**



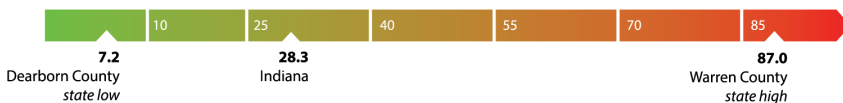
 **Lung cancer deaths** **47.1**
