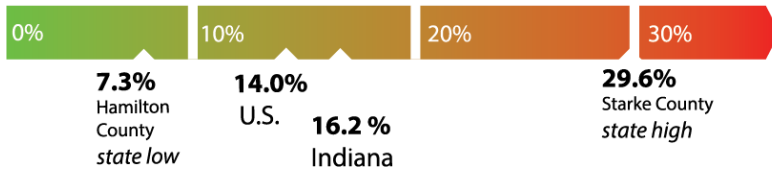


The state of tobacco control in Johnson County

Tobacco and Health in Johnson County

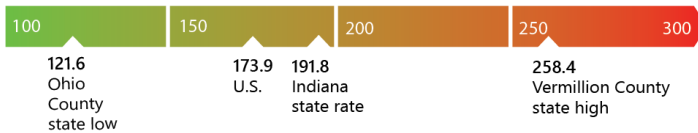
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **17.8%**



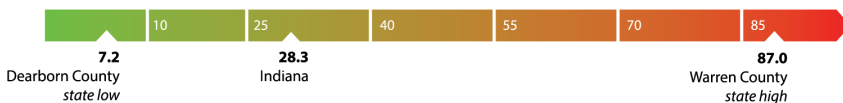
 **Lung cancer deaths** **44.2**
