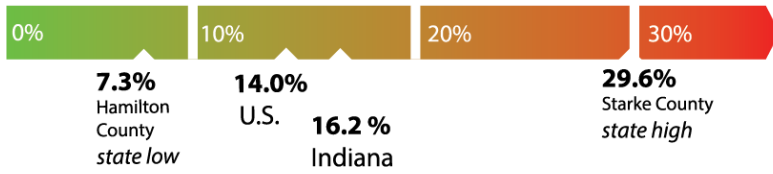


The state of tobacco control in LaGrange County

Tobacco and Health in LaGrange County

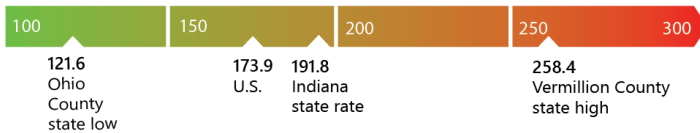
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **21.2%**



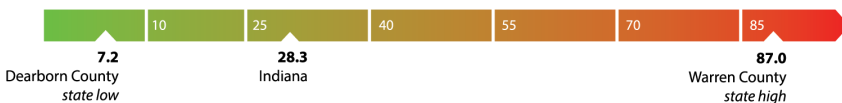
 **Lung cancer deaths** **43.9**
