

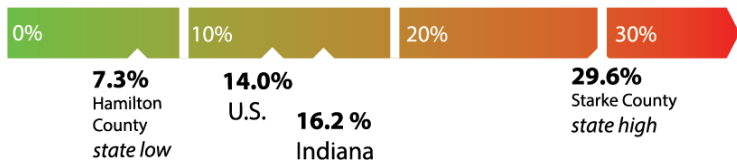

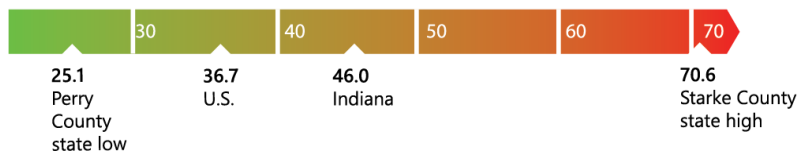

## Tobacco and Health in Marshall County

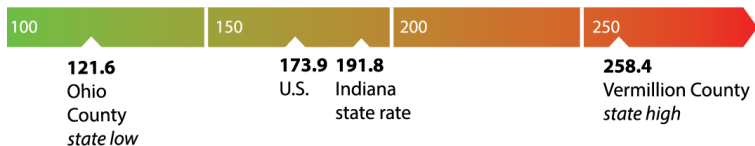
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **14.5%**



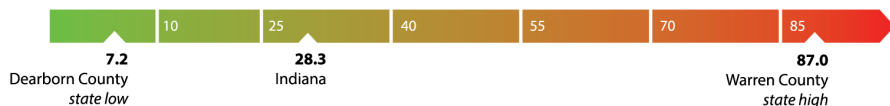
 **Lung cancer deaths** **42.2**
