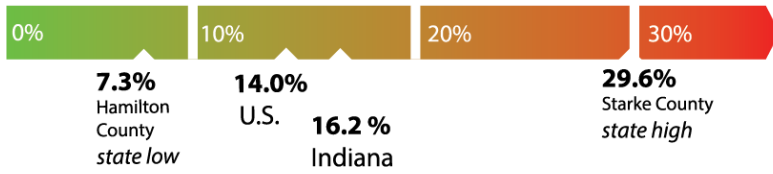


The state of tobacco control in Martin County

Tobacco and Health in Martin County

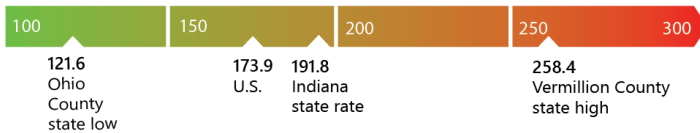
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **18.9%**



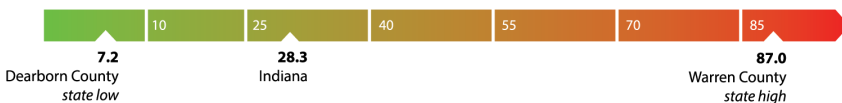
 **Lung cancer deaths** **58.5**
