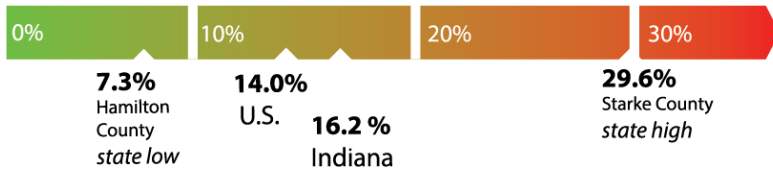


The state of tobacco control in Ohio County

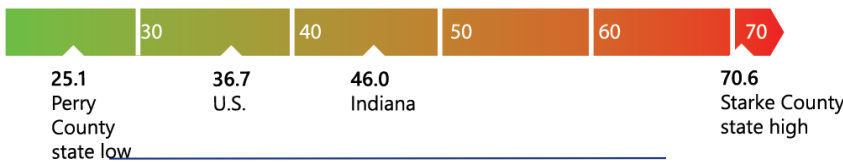
There is no tobacco control grant in Ohio County for 2023-2025.

Tobacco and Health in Ohio County

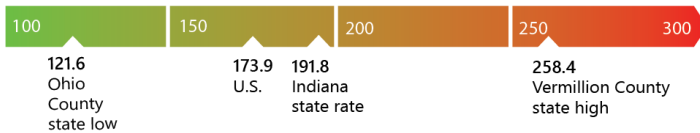
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **24.8%**



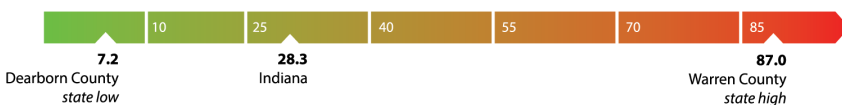
 **Lung cancer deaths** **53.7**
