

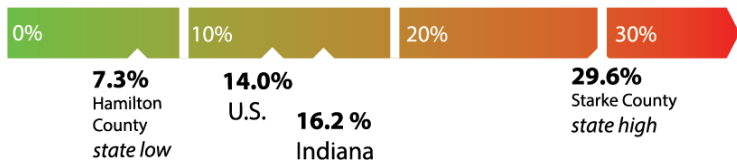

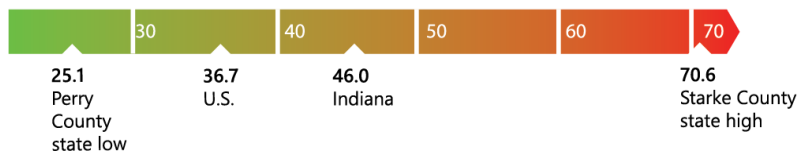

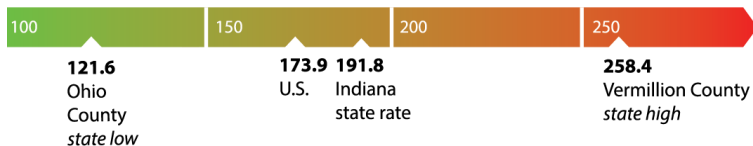
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **18.9%**



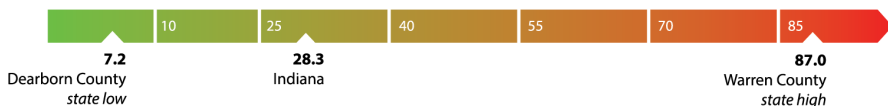
