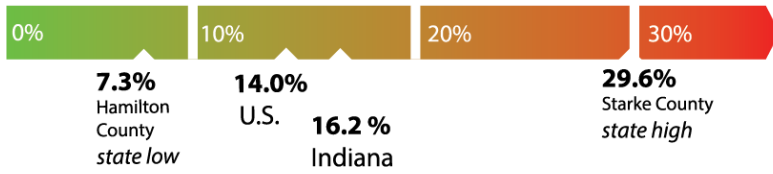


The state of tobacco control in Switzerland County

Tobacco and Health in Switzerland County

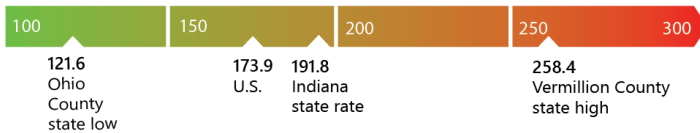
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **24.8%**



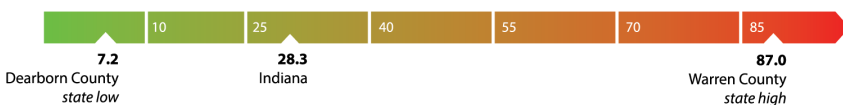
