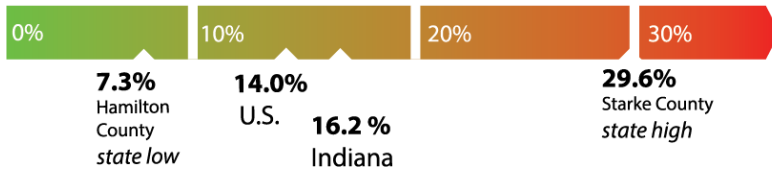


The state of tobacco control in Tipton County

Tobacco and Health in Tipton County

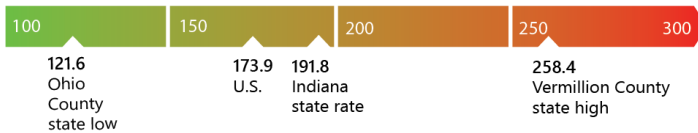
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **23.0%**



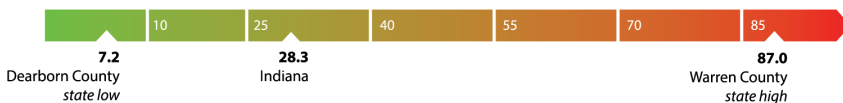
