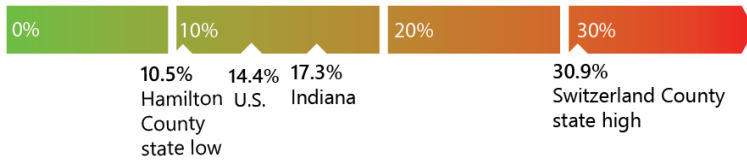

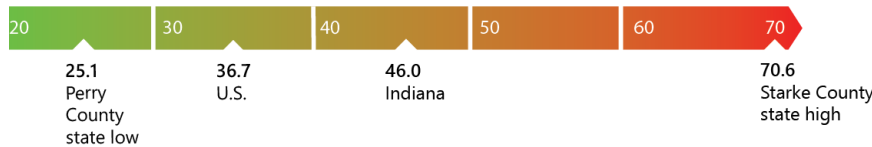
There is no tobacco control grant in Adams County for 2023-2025.

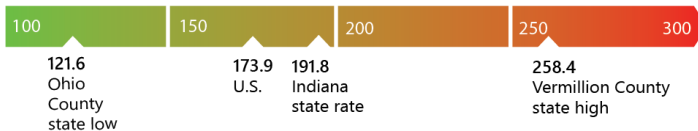
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **21.3%**



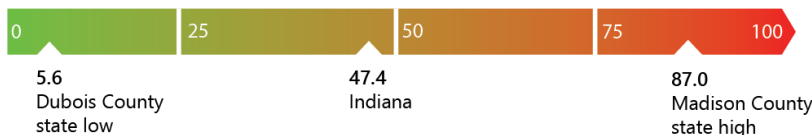
 **Lung cancer deaths** **48.4**
