

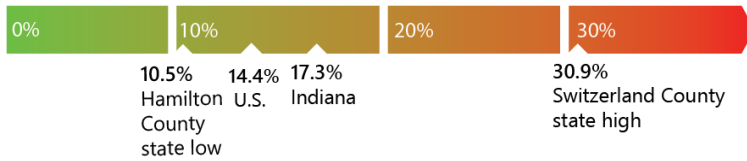

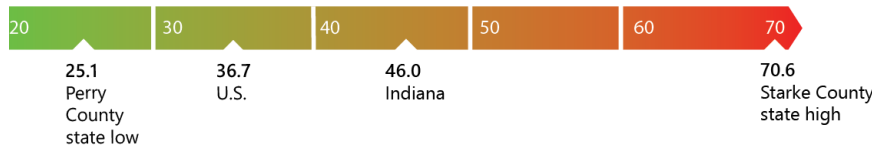

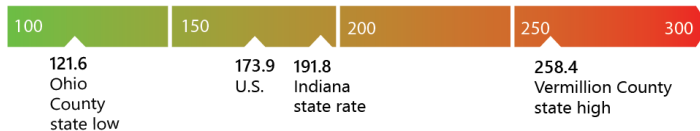
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **17.6%**



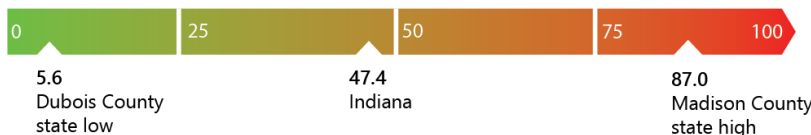
 **Lung cancer deaths** **34.6**
