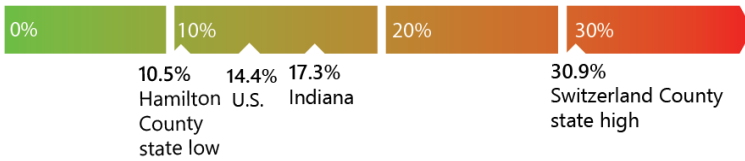

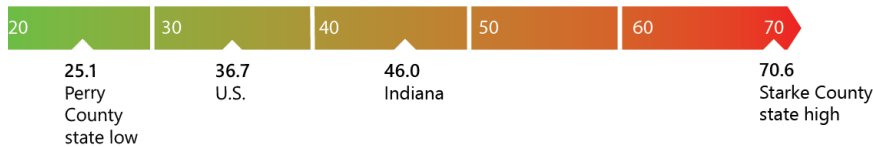

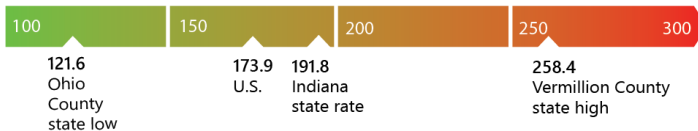
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **29.0%**



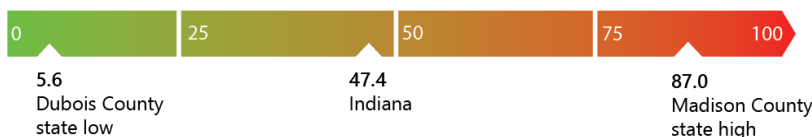
