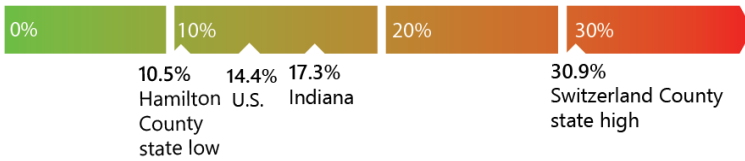

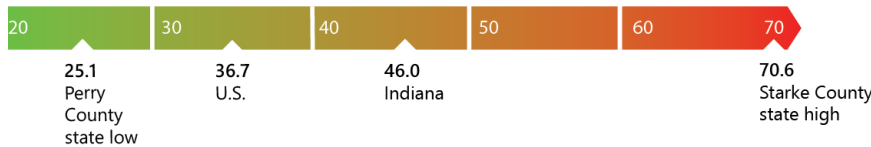
There is no tobacco control grant in Wells County for 2023-2025.

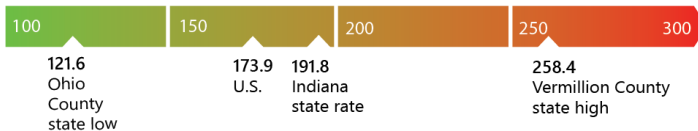
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **21.3%**



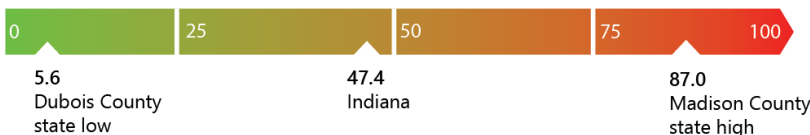
