### **Marker Text**

The Boone County REMC built Indiana's first electric cooperative line to the Clark Woody farm 5 miles west of this site with funds borrowed from the Rural Electrification Administration, July 22, 1935.

### **Report**

These markers were under review because IHB had no sources for the marker information on file and secondary sources were not easily located. However, further research into primary sources has shown that the marker text is correct. A November 1935 article in the *Lebanon Reporter* shows that the Boone County REMC did build Indiana's first electric cooperative line to Clark Woody's home, which was five miles west of where the current markers are located.
