10/30/2024	Swiftly Farms	Alleges the horse The Kid Pataky was improperly scratched from the 6th Race by the stewards at Horseshoe Indianapolis on October 26, 2024.	The horse was properly scratched from the 6th race when it received Lasix for the 2nd race, a race in which it had also been entered. The trainer desired to scratch the horse from the 2nd race, but the Lasix vet was never informed.	2/11/2025
10/2/2024	John DeLong	Alleges reckless and careless riding from a fellow driver during the 9th Race on September 21, 2024, at Hoosier Park.	The judges conducted a hearing and determined that no violations occurred during the race. Commission Staff reviewed the evidence and decided not to issue an administrative complaint. No violation.	11/15/2024
7/22/2024	Jeffrey L. Henry	Alleges that the #8 horse in the 3rd race at Horseshoe Indianapolis on June 29, 2024, was not given enough time to get ready in the gate before the gate was open to start the race.	In the opinion of the stewards, all of the horses were loaded into the gate in a legal and satisfactory manner and the jockey riding the #8 horse had more than ample time to get set and prepare for the start. No violation.	8/23/2024
6/13/2024	Eric M. Poders	Alleges that the 12th Race at Hoosier Park on June 8, 2024, was fixed due to "shenanigans going on in the race," with multiple drivers showing little to no effort in trying to compete.	In the judges' opinion, one driver made use of the passing lane and all drivers drove the race in a satisfactory manner and did not lack effort. An independent review determined there were no irregularities regarding wagering. No violation.	7/8/2024
