ADMINISTRATIVE ACTIONS, NOTES, COMMENTS

Race 1 – Inquiry posted on unofficial race winner No. 4 GALLEYS IMAGE (Patrizio Ancora) for possible pylon violation after 3/4s entering the stretch. Video showed Mr. Ancora's inside wheel striking two pylons while being inside of only one. The judges determined that this did not give the horse an unfair advantage and the horse was placed as finished.

Race 2 – Luke Plano, driver of No. 2 SEASIDE HANOVER, warned about his whip usage in the stretch which exhibited more than minimal wrist and elbow action.


Race 3 – No. 3 HOO NIEN A was a regular Lasix user. Announcements made via TV scroll and track announcer.


Race 10 – Inquiry posted on unofficial fourth place finisher No. 5 SOMETHING LIKETHAT (Darrell Wright) for possible interference to trailing horses going up the backstretch approaching the half. Trace Tetrick, driver of No. 8 DATING A VIRGIN, stated that the interference came from No. 5 causing his horse to make a break. Mr. Wright stated that the horses in front of him jammed up and he was the one that got interfered with. After reviewing video the judges determined that Mr. Wright caused his own problem by running up on the horse in front of him which in turn caused interference to trailing horses. No. 5 SOMETHING LIKETHAT finished fourth placed ninth for interference. Driver Darrell Wright fined \$200.00 for the infraction.



Race 12 – Inquiry posted on unofficial second place finisher No. 1 DAY OF LEGEND (Cristian Pacheco) for possible interference to unofficial third place finisher No. 2 SUPERFECTA HANOVER (Atlee Bender) nearing the finish. Replay showed the No. 1 DAY OF LEGEND change course into the path of No. 2 SUPERFECTA HANOVER causing interference. No. 1 DAY OF LEGEND finished second placed third. Driver Cristian Pacheco fined \$200.00 for interference causing a placing.
