ADMINISTRATIVE ACTIONS, NOTES, COMMENTS

Race 3 - General inquiry posted regarding No. 3 MR BLUTOS EXPRESS (Trace Tetrick) and whether or not the horse had broken equipment before the start. After reviewing video the judges determined that the horse's head pole broke after the field had been released by the starter. MR BLUTOS EXPRESS kept in the wagering poles and the horse was charted as break, "be" after the start.

Race 7 - Inquiry posted on unofficial fifth place finisher No. 2 TELLMETOTOUCHU (LeWayne Miller) for possible violation of the breaking rule in the far turn before and after the ¾ pole. Video showed that while off stride No. 2 TELLMETOTOUCHU caused interference to multiple trailing horses. For violation of the breaking rule No. 2 TELLMETOTOUCHU finished fifth placed tenth. No penalty to driver Miller.

Race 8 - Inquiry posted regarding No. 9 SWAN CATCHER (Kevin Lambright) making the fair start pole. Video confirmed that the horse had not passed the pole prior to the rest of the field being released by the starter. No. 9 SWAN CATCHER declared a non-starter for wagering purposes.

Race 10 - Recall charged to No. 10 TELLMETOTOUCHU for broken equipment before the start.

Race 11 – LeWayne Miller excused from his drives in race 11 and 13 due to a family emergency.
Inquiry posted on unofficial second place finisher No. 2 PRINCESS LAA (Dale Hiteman) for possible interference to unofficial ninth place finisher No. 1 BRANDONS GAL (Luke Plano) exiting the far turn at the top of the stretch. After speaking with driver Plano and reviewing video, the judges determined that there was not conclusive evidence to say that interference occurred at that point in the mile. Horses placed as finished.
