ADMINISTRATIVE ACTIONS, NOTES, COMMENTS

Race 2 – Inquiry posted on unofficial fourth place finisher No. 2 MYSTICAL LANE (John Moody) for possible pylon violation in the stretch. Replay showed that No. 2 MYSTICAL LANE was inside multiple pylons in the stretch and that Mr. Moody made no effort to correct his position until nearing the finish. For the pylon violation in the stretch No. 2 MYSTICAL LANE finished fourth placed eighth. Mr. Moody fined \$200.00 for a pylon violation causing a placing.


Mr. Moody was also observed failing to keep a line in each hand for the entire mile. Mr. Moody was also fined \$200.00 for this violation.

Race 5 – Inquiry posted on unofficial fourth place finisher No. 7 EMPIRE BUILDER (Marvin Luna) for possible violation of the breaking rule in the stretch. After reviewing video the judges determined that Mr. Luna complied with the breaking rule and while the horse was off stride at the finish no other horses were lapped on. No violation and the horse was placed as finished.

Race 6 - Inquiry posted on unofficial third place finisher No. 5 THREEFIFTYTWO (Rick Plano) for possible violation of the breaking rule at the start. After reviewing video the judges determined that Mr. Plano complied with the rule and the horse was placed as finished.

Race 11 – No. 9 SPLASH OF PINK charted with an equipment break after stepping out of a hobble in the stretch.

Race 13 – Inquiry posted on unofficial race winner No. 4 SHADY MAPLE AMBER (John De Long) for possible pylon violation in the stretch. Video showed that Mr. De Long hit a pylon, but did not go inside of any. Horse placed as finished.
