


Race 1 – Inquiry posted on unofficial second place finisher No. 1 ANGELATYOURFEET (Jordan Ross) for possible interference to unofficial fourth place finisher No. 3 BE TRUE TO ME (Kyle Wilfong) in the stretch. After reviewing video and speaking to driver Wilfong the judges determined that no violation occurred and the horses were placed as finished.


Race 2 – General inquiry posted regarding if No. 1 GREAT FLICK (LeWayne Miller) made the fair start pole. Video confirmed that the horse had not passed inside the pole prior to the rest of the field being released by the starter. No. 1 GREAT FLICK declared a starter for non-wagering purposes.

Race 9 – Inquiry posted on unofficial race winner No. 7 MONACO (Robert Taylor) for possible violation of the breaking rule at the start. After reviewing video the judges determined that Mr. Taylor complied with the breaking rule and the horse was placed as finished. Had the horse not won it would have been placed on the steward's list, however under IHRC rules a winning performance does not count against a horse making a break.

Race 11 – No. 9 FRED'S FINALE (Kyle Wilfong) pulled up and did not finish after breaking a hopple before the half.
