

ADMINISTRATIVE ACTIONS, NOTES, COMMENTS

Race 1 - Daryl Bontrager, driver of No. 3 SILVER CRUSADER, fined \$100.00 for failure to set and maintain a proper pace.

Race 5 - Inquiry posted on unofficial first place finisher No. 1 BROOKVIEW HERSHEY (Kevin Detweiler) for possible violation of the breaking rule in late stretch through the finish. While the horse was lapped on by the second place horse, No. 4 PRINCESS DRAVEN, the judges determined that the horse needed to be placed farther back. The horse was sitting second when she made the break and passed the No. 4 to win the race. The judges determined that the horse not only failed to lose ground, but actually gained ground while on the break. For failure to lose ground while on a break, No. 1 BROOKVIEW HERSHEY finished first placed seventh.
