ADMINISTRATIVE ACTIONS, NOTES, COMMENTS

Race 3 - Inquiry posted on unofficial third place finisher No. 3 BABY BE BETTER (Ronald Burks) for possible pylon violation in the stretch. After reviewing video the judges determined that No. 3 BABY BE BETTER was not forced inside pylons by No. 5 FOX VALLEY BOXER (Travis Seekman) and that going inside the pylons gave the horse a definite unfair advantage. For a pylon violation No. 3 BABY BE BETTER finished third placed eighth. Driver Ron Burks fined \$200.00 for a pylon violation causing a placing.

Race 6 – No. 5 FOX VALLEY SNAPPER raced without hind shoes.


The scratch of No. 6 UNHYNGED CADEAU reduced the field to five betting interests. Per IHRC rules, superfecta wagering on the race was cancelled.


Race 8 – Inquiry posted on unofficial fourth place finisher No. 4 SWAN JAYDEN (Jordan Ross) for possible violation of the breaking rule before 3/4s. After reviewing video the judges determined that Mr. Ross complied with the breaking rule and the horse was placed as finished.

Race 10 – Inquiry posted on unofficial third place finisher No. 8 ASSISTANT COACH (Atlee Bender) for possible violation of the breaking rule in late stretch. While off stride the judges determined that No. 8 ASSISTANT COACH interfered with No. 1 CANTTOUCHMETHERE. No. 1 finished second ahead of the 8, and the judges also determined that Mr. Bender complied with the breaking rule. The horse was placed as originally finished.

Race 12 – The early scratch of No. 1 PILOTS LEGACY followed by the vet scratch of No. 4 LANZADOR reduced the field from seven to five betting interests. As in the earlier race (6th) superfecta wagering on the race was cancelled. No. 3 PONDA SWAN (Marcus Miller) originally finished fourth placed fifth for an extended break after the start.

Race 14 – Two separate inquires posted. The first concerning unofficial second place finisher No. 1 BOMBS AWAY CAPTAIN (Travis Seekman) for possible interference to No. 5 ALL RUMORS (John DeLong) past the 1/4 going up the backstretch. Video showed that No. 1 BOMBS AWAY CAPTAIN came out late into the path of No. 5 ALL RUMORS causing that one to make a break. For interference causing a horse to make a break No. 1 BOMBS AWAY CAPTAIN finished second placed tenth. The second incident occurred in the stretch involving unofficial sixth place finisher No. 8 TL CHAMPAIGN ROCKS (Kyle Husted) for possible interference to unofficial eighth place finisher No. 7 JK'S SPIRIT (Dan Shetler). Video showed No. 8 TL CHAMPAIGN ROCKS come out late under No. 7 JK'S SPIRIT causing Shetler to grab his horse up. For interference in the stretch No. 8 TL CHAMPAIGN ROCKS finished sixth placed fifth (via the first DQ) placed seventh. Both drivers Seekman and Husted fined \$200.00 for interference.
