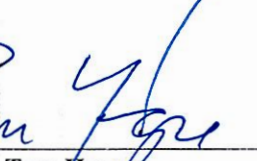

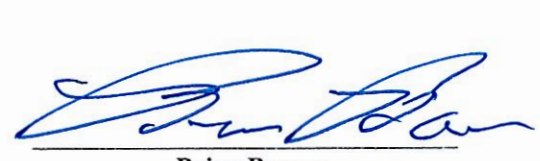
****Delay before the start of the first race due to malfunctioning photo finish equipment. Per IHRC rule 71 IAC 4-3-4 “an association shall provide an electronic photo finish device to photograph and the finish of each race and record the time of each horse in at least hundredths of a second.” This delay lasted approximately 25 minutes.****

Race 8- Inquiry posted on unofficial fourth place finisher No. 5 FIFTY DALLAR DIVA (Jordan Ross) for possible violation of the breaking rule in the stretch. After reviewing video the judges determined that the horse gained ground while initially on the break. For failing to continuously lose ground in violation of IHRC breaking rules No. 5 FIFTY DALLAR DIVA finished fourth placed fifth.

Race 12- Inquiry posted on unofficial race winner No. 2 CLASSICOBSERVATION (Brandon Bates) for possible interference to unofficial third place finisher No. 8 BLUE BALOU after 3/4 entering the stretch. After reviewing video and speaking with both drivers the judges did determine that interference occurred. No. 2 CLASSICOBSERVATION finished first placed third. Driver Bates fined \$200.00 for interference causing a placing.
