ADMINISTRATIVE ACTIONS, NOTES, COMMENTS

Race 4 – Carson Conrad, driver of No. 5 DON'T FORGET ME, fined \$300.00 for whipping other than wrist and elbow action. Mr. Conrad called the judges and apologized for his actions.

Race 6 – Pete Wrenn, driver of No. 10 NIKES SHINING STAR, fined \$50.00 for failure to drive when programmed. Inquiry posted concerning the start. Video shows that No. 1 BIG DOVER made a break before the start but did not interfere with the trailer No. 10 NIKES SHINING STAR. Horses placed as finished.

Race 7 – Inquiry posted on unofficial fourth place finisher No. 5 ALWAYS A MILLER (Kyle Wilfong) for possible violation of the breaking rule in the stretch through the finish. After reviewing video the judges determined that: 1) driver Wilfong complied with all aspects of the breaking rule, 2) the horse was not lapped on by other horses at the finish, 3) the horse did not make an extended break. With no breaking rule violations occurring the horse was placed as finished.

Race 8 - Joey Putnam, driver of No. 6 ATTORNEY AT LAW, fined \$50.00 for failure to drive when programmed.

Race 8 (cont.) – General inquiry posted looking at an incident that occurred past the quarter. While it first appeared that the confusion started near the front of the field, driver Jordan Ross stated that his horse No. 1 WHISTLE SHOOTER made a break after shying from the No. 2 SILVERHSOE HALIE. No. 1 WHISTLE SHOOTER finished sixth placed ninth for interference to trailing horses while on a break.

Race 11 – No. 4 LA LA LOLA originally finished ninth placed tenth for a pylon violation in the far turn. No penalty to driver John DeLong as the horse as initially taken inside for safety reasons while on a break.

Race 14 - Recall caused by a power surge which caused all four cameras to go down for approximately four minutes.
