

2020 PROPOSAL

Approved by the Standardbred Breed Development Advisory Committee on 11/22/19.

2019 was another amazing year for the Indiana Horse Racing Industry and our Standardbred program with Indiana Sired horses continuing to make national headlines. Our state continues to produce quality horses which can compete with the nations' best. Our program is well represented nationally with showings from Indiana sired horses in almost all major stakes events. Indiana Sired horses continue to be in high demand. A total of 358 Indiana-sired yearlings averaged \$18,028, grossing \$6.45 million. Additionally, the sale made history when two Indiana sired trotters sold for \$175,000 each, the most an Indiana sired yearling has brought at public auction.

In planning the Standardbred Breed Development Program for 2020, the Standardbred Breed Development Advisory Committee and Standardbred Advisory Board worked closely with Hoosier Park and the Indiana Standardbred Association. Our biggest challenge in crafting the program was how to address the increase in funding the program will see from the implementation of table games beginning January 1, 2020. After many discussions, we agreed the best approach would be to utilize our budget without any additions from table games, however utilizing some funding from our reserves. In addition, we would like to revisit the program after we have a few months of table games operations completed, and may bring a modification to our program back to the IHRC at that time. Our goal is continue to look at ways in which we can improve this already successful program, consider input from all stakeholders and try to formulate long term plans.

Overview of 2020 Program (Modifications made in bold)

Indiana Sires Stakes

Significant changes were made to the structure of the Indiana Sires Stakes program for 2019, and the new structure worked well. Overall, the program paid out over \$8.8 million in purses, an increase of over \$1 million from the amount paid in 2018. We would like to continue with this structure, only making minor improvements. The 2020 Indiana Sires Stakes Program will feature:

- Six legs for 2-Year-Olds leading up to a \$250,000 Super Final
- Eight legs for 3-Year-Olds leading up to a \$250,000 Super Final
- Super Final Participants finishing 6th through 10th will receive a \$4,000 purse payout each for earning their way into Super Finals
- Addition of \$25,000 consolations for all two and three year old categories
- Budgeting in \$100,000 for rounding of legs and boosting of purses in legs with 11 starters. Even though the purse amounts are fixed, we did not include a contingency for this in the 2019 program. We are including \$100,000 to account for these occurrences.

Funding for the program will be structured as follows:

- Nomination fees will be retained by the Breed Development Fund. Nomination fees will remain at \$500.
- > Entry fee for each leg will be \$500.
- There will not be an entry fee required for the Super Final.
- ➤ Breed Development will fund the purse, \$250,000 for the Super Final (for top ten horses from Leg Finals) plus the \$4,000 each 6th through 10th place finisher will receive. For a total payout of \$270,000.
- ➤ In legs with a field of 11 starters, an additional 6% of the purse will be paid with 3% to the sixth place finisher, 2% to the seventh place finisher, 1% to the eighth place finisher.
- ➤ Hoosier Park agrees to write overnight races for Sires Stakes eligible horses to provide additional racing opportunities. These races will run concurrent with the Sires Stakes program. Breed Development will earmark a minimum of \$500,000 from the funds allocated for IS Overnight/Mini Series Budget.

Indiana Sired Fair Circuit

The fair program continues to be an important part of the Indiana program. In reviewing the program for 2020, the program will remain the same with minor improvements. They are:

- Increase purses for the Championship Races at the Indiana State Fair from \$20,000 to \$25,000 and Consolation races from \$8,000 to \$10,000.
- Lower \$ earnings cap on Series 2 to NW \$10,000 up to completion of Series 1. Exact date to be determined once fair schedule is finalized.
- Add an overnight race at each fair for each gait and age. Horses nominated to the fair program will be eligible to enter into this race. The purse will be \$1,000 plus entry fees (\$25 per horse). If the race splits into divisions, the purse will be divided.

Horses competing in these races will not receive any points toward the Championship races. These races will only be held during the first series. Rules from the ISFC conditions (such as the 5 day rule) will also apply. The races will be:

- ISFC Nominated 2 YR Old Pace NW \$4,000 in 2020 \$1,000
- o ISFC Nominated 2 YR Old Trot NW \$4,000 in 2020 \$1,000
- O ISFC Nominated 3 YR Old Pace NW \$4,000 in 2020 \$1,000
- o ISFC Nominated 3 YR Old Trot NW \$4,000 in 2020 \$1,000

The structure of the 2020 program is as follows:

- Pay \$500 to each $6^{th} 8^{th}$ place finisher in the Series 1 Championship races
- Approximately 23 racing programs to be held (including ISA Elite Program & Championships).

Series 1:

- Purses \$3,000 Division
- Championship \$20,000 \$25,000
- Consolation \$8,000 \$10,000

Series 2:

- for NW \$12,000 \$10,000 in 2020 up to and including 8/15/20. (please note that this date may need to be modified depending the fair schedule which is not set until January)
- Purses \$3,000 Division
- Championship \$10,000

Other Races At Fairs

ISA Elite – Breed Development will continue to support this event. ISA Elite Races to be funded at \$5,000 \$7,000 per category as follows (Please note the additional \$2,000 has been funded by the Standardbred Advisory Board in the past. Their budget cannot sustain this long term so it is being shifted to the Breed Development Fund):

- 2 YR Filly Pace \$5,000 \$7,000
- 2 YR Filly Trot \$5,000 \$7,000
- 2 YR Colt Pace \$5,000 \$7,000

Breeder's Awards

Continue the current format from 2013.

- Total Payout for Breeder's Awards \$700,000 **\$800,000**
- A horse must win an eligible race to be eligible to the Breeder's Award Pool. The criteria is as follows:
 - Two & Three Year Olds ISB Horses only that win any race at the Pari-Mutuel Tracks in Indiana or ISFC Championship Races excluding any race in which the horse is entered for a claiming price.
 - o Four Nine Year Olds ISB Horses that win:
 - Final of any Breed Development Indiana Sired Late Closer Event
 - Elimination or Final of the Indiana Sires Stakes
 - Track's Open or Invitational Race
 - Excluding any race in which the horse is entered for a claiming price.
 - o Aged Horses (11 years old & older) IS Horses that win:
 - Final of any Breed Development Indiana Sired Late Closer Event
 - Elimination or Final of the Indiana Sires Stakes
 - Track's Open or Invitational Race
 - Excluding any race in which the horse is entered for a claiming price.
- Awards will be distributed to eligible breeder's based on the percentage win earnings of the total
 win earnings available. For example (please note that the example provided includes only a small
 sample of horses, there will be a much larger number of horses eligible for awards):

• Breeder's Awards will be paid on an annual basis, at the completion of the last race meet in Indiana.

Indiana Sired Overnight Supplements/Mini Series

Keep format of this program the same, however total amount available is \$2,000,000 \$2,200,000.

- Total Payout for Indiana Sired Overnights/Mini Series \$2,000,000 \$2,200,000
- Overnight races which fill with all Indiana Sired (or ISB) horses will be boosted by 15%.
- Hoosier Park will be allocated \$2,200,000 to fund overnight races/mini series which fill with all Indiana Sired horses. Once this allocation is met, the race track purse account will be responsible for funding any remaining races.
- Hoosier Park agrees to write overnight races for Sires Stakes eligible horses to provide additional racing opportunities. These races will run concurrent with the Sires Stakes program. Breed Development will earmark a minimum of \$500,000 from the funds allocated for IS Overnight/Mini Series Budget.

Indiana Sired Late Closers

- Total BDF Payout for Indiana Sired Late Closers \$750,000 \$850,000
- Purse Account contribution to remain at \$4,000 per leg
- Purses have been increased to encourage greater participation and account for potential overnight purse increases from table games.
- The Committee would also like to request the ability to review and add an additional late closing series for the end of the racing meet if funds are available.
