State Coordinator's Report

Marion County Grant Request

Corridan: Marion County has submitted a grant request to the NHPRC. We have to

grade it. Each member will have to submit a grading form.

Action: The Marion County request to the NHPRC will not be recommended for

funding to the NHPRC as written.

IMLS Grant & GSU Meeting

Corridan: We're applying for a \$I Million IMLS grant with a group of 11 to 13 states. We have a 40-percent chance of receiving it. The meeting in Utah was very beneficial. They're using open source indexing and collecting naturalization records. They're able to speed indexing up to months from years or decades. It would require approval from the Governor's office or the State legislature. The work we're doing is being recognized as positive.

CoSA & NAGARA

Corridan: Our annual meeting is in two weeks. I've been asked to be the president-elect. We'll review our environmental scan discussion from our last meeting. Indiana has excess LSTA funds. We're trying to do a \$75,000 grant with the State Archives and CoSA. We'll hire people to do an environmental scan. It's a very worthwhile study.

State Archives Building

Corridan: We've had heavy rain at the Archives. As a result there has been significant water in the Archives. We had water in the conservation lab chemical cabinet, one-inch deep in the stacks, and water in the acid-free box storage room. This is the third or fourth time we've had water damage but have lost no records. The budget committee is meeting around September 5th and may approve funds for a new roof. The Governor is appointing a bicentennial commission in July. It will be a mix of business and history people.

Grants and Workshops

Corridan: Board members will review the grant applications. We need to allow the Board till July 15 to review. Members must respond with one of three standards: accept, accept with modification, and reject.

Motion: Witcher-Bantin, motion carries.

Corridan: ICPR will work with applicants with Board approval.
