- C. A copy of high school transcripts, recommendation letters from two teachers and an essay must accompany entry essay forms. The essay must address the above-cited topic. The essay must not exceed 300 words. <u>NO exceptions.</u> The essay must be typed double-spaced on plain paper.
- D. Contest entries become the property of the sponsor.
- E. Judges for the final selection are selected members of the Indiana Consortium of State and Local Human Rights Agencies. All entries will be judged anonymously.
