Primary and secondary lead standards were established in October 1978 at a level of 1.5 micrograms per cubic meter ( $\mu\text{g}/\text{m}^3$ ) (43 FR 46246). All other areas of Indiana not listed above were designated attainment/unclassifiable under the 1978 annual lead standard.

Attainment of the 1978 annual lead standard was determined by evaluating each calendar quarter arithmetic average, which must not exceed  $1.5 \mu\text{g}/\text{m}^3$  over a three-year period. The 1978 lead standard was replaced by a new lead standard in October 2008 set at a level of  $0.15 \mu\text{g}/\text{m}^3$  (73 FR 66964). All areas of Indiana met the 1978 lead standard at the time it was replaced with the annual 2008 lead standard.
