Recommendation of Award for a period of 4 years with an estimated amount of \$1,275,509.05

Based on the evaluation of the responses received for Negotiated Bid #61-25-80811, **Blunk Safety Systems Inc.** is recommended for award to provide Emergency Vehicle Lighting for All State Agencies. Terms of this recommendation are outlined in this letter.

The State received bids from two (2) Respondents:

- Blunk Safety Systems Inc.
- Federal Signal Corporation

The solicitation was issued as a Negotiated Bid for a period of (4) years of the following line items in Table 1:


Blunk Safety Systems Inc. claimed the U.S. Manufactured, Indiana Business, and Indiana Small Business preference. Federal Signal Corporation claimed the U.S. Manufactured preference. The Evaluation Amounts after preferences were applied were unchanged and are detailed in Table 3 below.
