### **Project Wins and Activities**


Project DELTA is currently on-track for a full launch in early 2023. Below are some of the most recent 'wins' as well as upcoming activities.

#### Recent Project "Wins":

- Released Sprint #4, which includes additional approved system configuration with input from key IDOC stakeholders and the Change Board
- · Onboarded additional Testing resources to support project quality assurance
- · Baselined the project schedule, including updating select project tasks
- Conducted a Trust Fund Retrospective to discuss lessons learned, providing guidance on how to best prepare for future Project DELTA go-live activities
- Reviewed the new Case Plan Credit Time process to determine a timeline for implementation and potential impact on Project DELTA

#### **Upcoming Activities:**

- Release Data Migration iteration #2 work items, which will enhance the data available in the UAT environment for Sentencing, Classification, Intake, Case Management, and Parole
- Release Work Items in Sprint #5, allowing IDOC users to experience new functionality for the Intake, Case Management, Parole, Classification, and Admin
- Discuss a Disaster Recovery Plan and dry run to validate that Trust Fund activity can continue in the event of an unforeseen event
