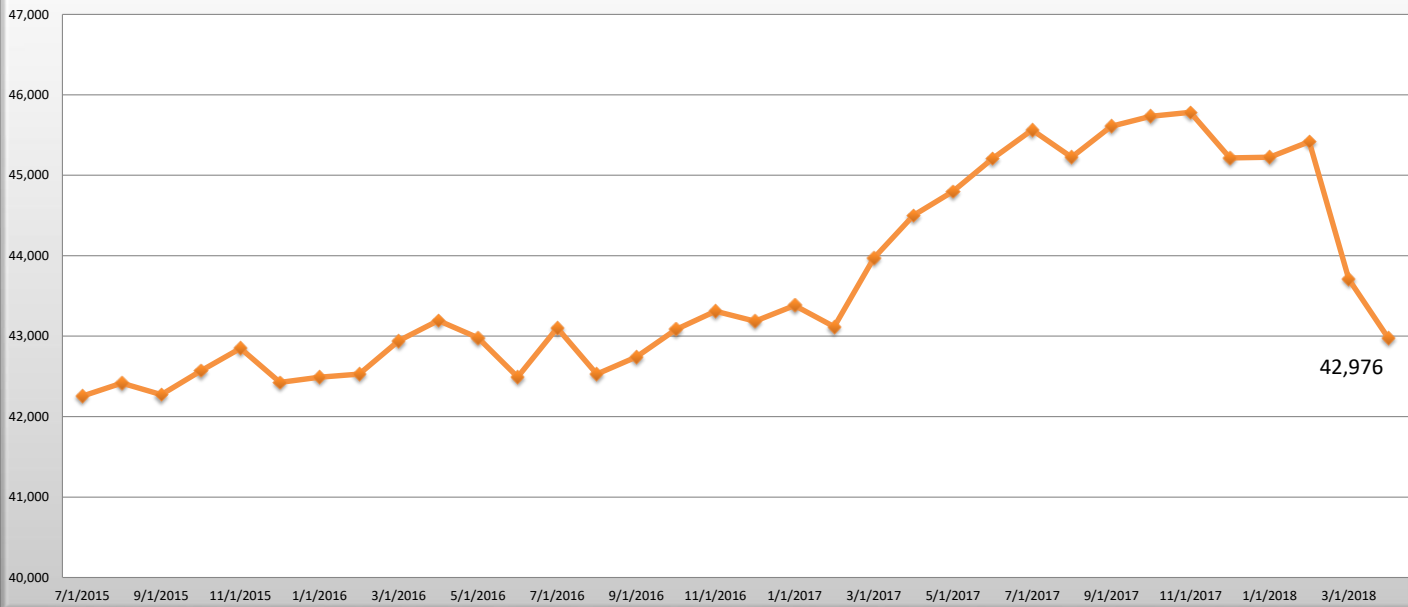

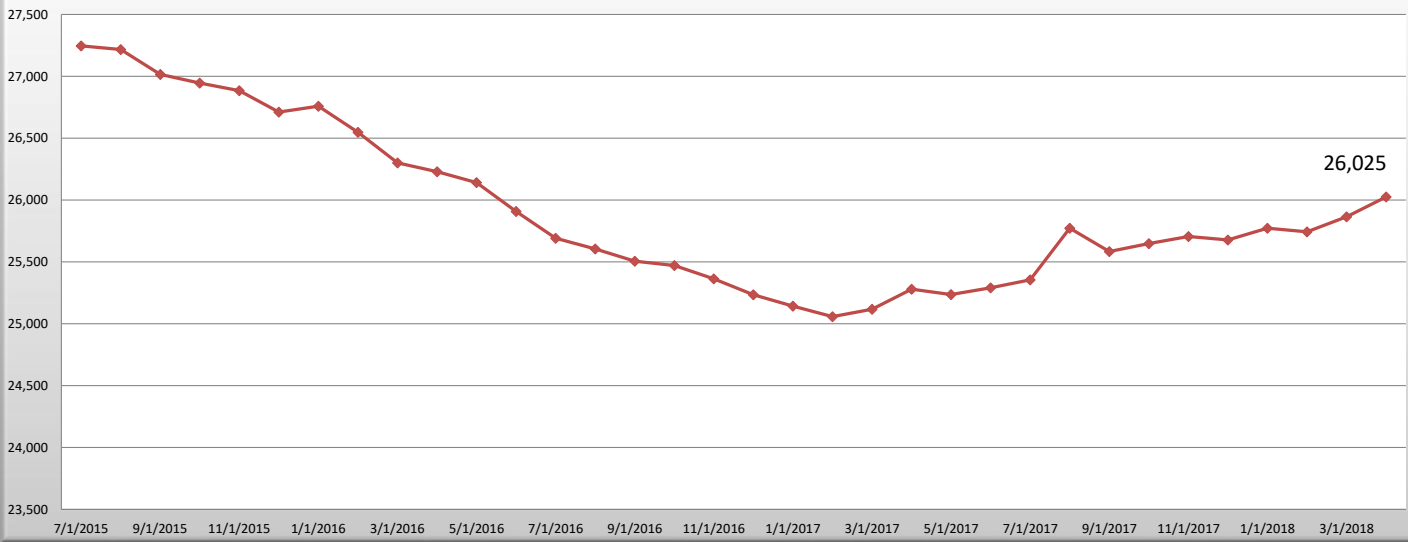

DOC Population Trend



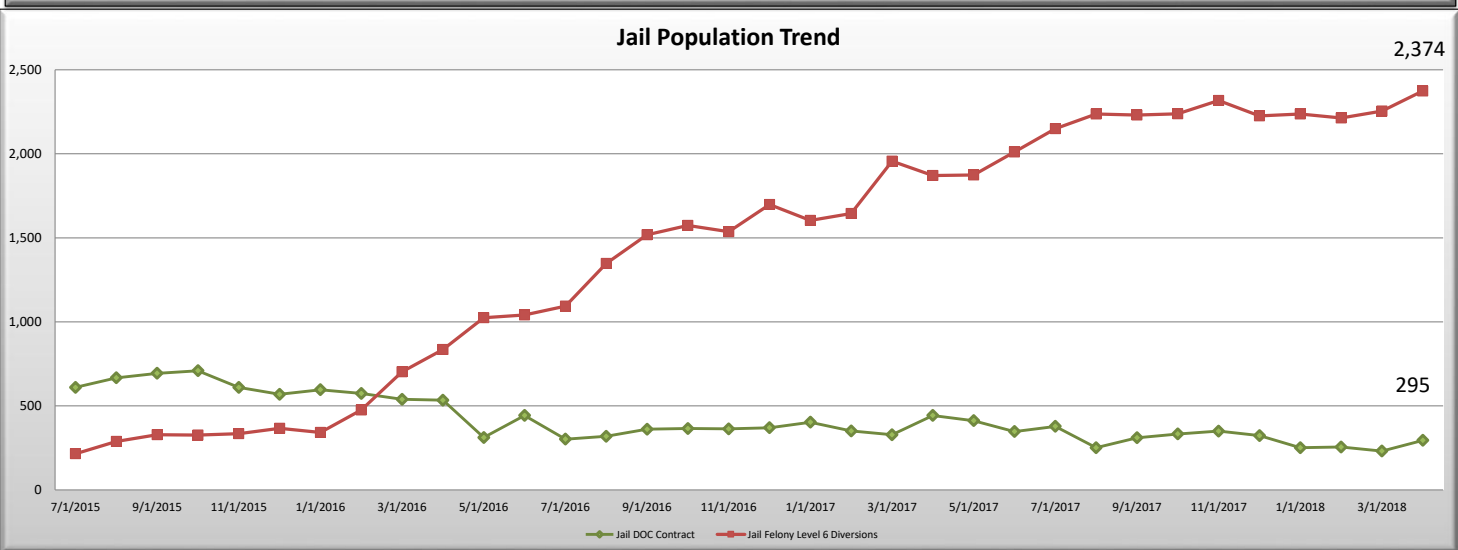
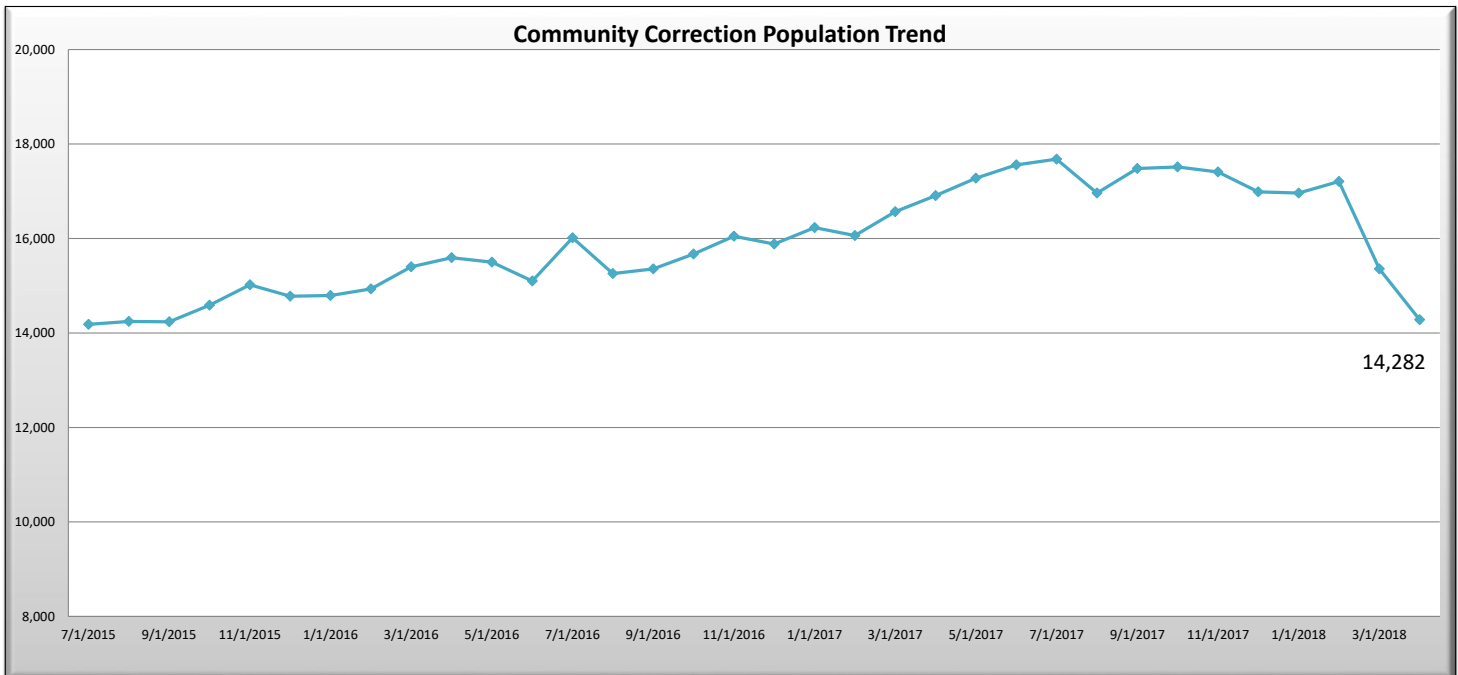
