### **Offender Walk Away Apprehended**

Indianapolis, Indiana (July 21, 2011) – An offender from the Indianapolis Re-entry Educational Facility, who walked away from a work crew this afternoon, is in custody.

Offender Casey Cockerham, age 29, was apprehended without incident at approximately 5:30 p.m. in Indianapolis by Correctional Police Officers from the Indiana Department of Correction (IDOC).

Cockerham was reported missing from a work crew in downtown Indianapolis at 12:30 p.m. on Thursday, July 21, 2011. Indiana State Police were immediately notified.

Cockerham, from Seymour, IN, is serving a 10-year sentence for Dealing Cocaine. He arrived at the Indianapolis Re-entry Educational Facility on June 14, 2011. His earliest possible release date is April, 20, 2013.

IDOC Commissioner Bruce Lemmon expressed gratitude to all law enforcement agencies involved for their diligent efforts to apprehend Offender Cockerham.
