




Graph 1: Population Trend, Total




Graph 2: Population Trend, DOC Adult

- (3) As of January 1, 2021, all Marion County Community Corrections Pretrial participants were transferred to Marion County Probation for supervision, resulting in a significant decrease in the total population.

  As of January 1, 2023 Pretrial participants were transferred back to Marion County Community Corrections for supervision, resulting in a significant increase in the total population.
- (4) As of January 2022, all Community Corrections data is self-reported and uniformly collected under the Supervised Release System (SRS). (Chart does not include Murder)



Graph 6: Facility Population: New Felony Levels




Graph 8: Admission and Release Totals


