What do I need to know this month?

- The Change Agent Network has launched:
 - This group of nearly 150 IDOC staff is representative of all IDOC facilities and classifications. These individuals will help provide additional input on the project and will share important information to staff.
- Change Agents are also helping assess the preparedness of staff within each facility for the DELTA system. These assessments will occur monthly and Change Agents may ask staff for feedback in order to complete each assessment.



Who's involved with Project DELTA?

- In addition to the new Change Agent Network, the project's Change Board continues to provide critical input into the project, including the 26 functionality areas (known as modules)
- The Change Board consists of cross-functional stakeholders, all of whom provide guidance, input and feedback as we make design/configuration decisions
