We're excited to share that **Instructors** from facilities and classifications across the agency **are currently undergoing training during a "train-the-trainer" program**, facilitated by select module owners and subject matter experts! These Instructors are learning the DELTA system and business processes **in preparation for training all IDOC staff** prior to go-live.

In-person training for staff will begin in January 2023 and will be conducted by IDOC Instructors at 6 regional training locations (in addition to parole districts) across the state.
