DELTA Launches Monday, May 15th!

Our go-live of the DELTA system will be on Monday, May 15th (extended from April 24th). As a reminder, this decision was not made lightly, but based on input and feedback from our Module Owners, our Steering Committee, IOT and others – including the Governor's Office - DOC Leadership believes it to be the decision in the best interest of our staff & agency.

As shared last week in an agency-wide email, addressing the preparedness needs of our staff ahead of the go-live of DELTA is of the utmost importance. We believe this decision will allow us to improve your experience while providing additional time to become more comfortable with DELTA.

Pilot #2 is April 24th-28th!

The Project DELTA team is conducting a 2nd Pilot from April 24th to April 28th. As you may know, we recently conducted our first Pilot at 6 locations across the state (Central Office, Rockville, South Bend, Wabash Valley, Logansport Juvenile, and Madison Parole District).

During our initial Pilot participants provided the project team with invaluable feedback, which we've been actively working to address around the clock since it ended on March 31st. We've taken steps to enhance our 2nd Pilot with additional functionality, new support processes, bug fixes & more that we believe will lead to a more successful go-live experience for all DOC staff.
