COVID Guidance For COA

The CDC recently issued updated guidance for the general public which, in the case of IDOC, only currently applies to employees in Business (BU) 00615 (Central Office), Parole and ICI. Employees whose work location/space is in Central Office, Parole or ICI, where they report to on a regular basis, are the only divisions/employees that the new guidance applies to.

The updated guidance is below:

Health Criteria	You are fully vaccinated** or prior COVID positive test within the last three months	You are NOT vaccinated
Exposed to COVID-19 Close contact to a person who has tested positive for COVID-19 <i>(Within 6 ft. of an infected person for a cumulative total of 15 mins or more over a 24-hour period)</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No quarantine indicated. Watch for symptoms for 10 days. Test on day five, if possible. If symptoms develop, stay home and get tested. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> If positive, follow below guidance. If negative, return to the office once symptoms have resolved with strict mask adherence. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Stay home and quarantine for at least 5 days. Watch for symptoms for 10 days. Test on day five, if possible. If symptoms develop, stay home and get tested. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> If positive, follow below guidance. If negative, return to the office once symptoms have resolved with strict mask adherence.
Tested Positive for COVID-19 or Have Symptoms*	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Isolate at home at least 5 days from symptom onset or positive test (if no symptoms). If symptomatic, isolation ends after a minimum of 5 calendar days AND fever-free for 24 hours unmedicated AND improvement of COVID-19 symptoms. May return to Central Office, Parole or ICI on Day 6, but MUST wear a mask at all times. Cannot enter a facility until Day 10. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Isolate at home at least 5 days from symptom onset or positive test (if no symptoms). If symptomatic, isolation ends after a minimum of 5 calendar days AND fever-free for 24 hours unmedicated AND improvement of COVID-19 symptoms. May return to Central Office, Parole or ICI on Day 6, but MUST wear a mask at all times. Cannot enter a facility until Day 10.

COVID-19 Symptoms: fever, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, chills, cough, fatigue, muscle/body aches, headache, sore throat, nasal congestion/runny nose, new loss of taste or smell, vomiting or diarrhea.

Fully vaccinated: completed Pfizer or Moderna series within the last six months
OR completed J&J series within the last three months AND received booster.
