What's included in this module:

Appropriate custody levels are tracked and managed by IDOC in the Classification module. There are separate instruments for male and female offenders as well as adult and juvenile offenders. DELTA addresses both external (custody level, minimum security level, etc.) and internal (disposition, behavior, etc.) classification needs.

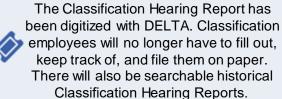






Module: Classification

Key Changes?





In DELTA, sentence restrictions will appear on the initial classification review. This eliminates the need to visit multiple screens to view this contextual information.



On the Escape Screen, users will have access to greater amounts of detailed information, in one location, on the type and date of escape convictions.



Judicial Recommendations will become a case note. This will allow line of site into details around the Offender's history and sentencing classifications. There will be a hyperlink to the case note in the initial classification review.



Additional information about escapes and demographics will be captured in DELTA. This allows for more information to be searched and incorporated in Classification.



There will be a new Classification
Designation Scoring Tool, in which a lot
of data will be auto-scored. This will
save time and reduce errors.

What will be the same?



All classification information in OIS will be in DELTA.



All over-arching processes, such as Detainers, Flags, and Monitoring, will be represented in DELTA.
