Key Changes?



The STG profiles in DELTA will consolidate all STG-related data into one area. This eliminates the need to go back and forth between more than one system.



Signatures for STG-related processes will be automatically routed to the appropriate people using action queues.



Monikers for all offenders can be stored in DELTA on the Offender Data Screen, instead of only STG offenders. This allows for enhanced documentation of monikers commonly used by many offenders.



In DELTA, all documents related to STG evidence will be uploaded and stored in DELTA, instead of just listed. This will allow STG Coordinators and Investigators to view STG evidence in a single system.



Tattoo photos can be uploaded to DELTA on the Offender Data Screen. This will make it much easier to track these physical identifiers and document when a tattoo changes throughout an offender's incarceration period.

What will be the same?



The process for developing STG profiles will not change



The approval path for STG profiles will remain the same
