# Module: Movement

## Key Changes?



The Transportation Queue is a centralized dashboard that displays the relevant Transportation & Movement Information for offenders. Multiple offenders can be viewed at once, and it can be filtered by Facility, Movement Reason, Priority Offenders, etc.



Movement Types and Movement Codes will be different in DELTA.



The Offender Traffic History screen shows the history of both intra and inter facility transfers. This screen can be filtered by Movement Type, Movement Dates, Movement Codes, and Movement Reason.



The FITS tool in DELTA will automatically assist staff in finding suitable locations for offender transfers.



The High Risk flag will be determined from a Category 6 monitoring instance only. I&I will not be a source for determining whether an offender is High Risk. High Risk will use "In-House Hold" as the Movement Type.



There will be a new route planning tool in DELTA for tracking and planning transfer routes.

## What will be the same?



Most of the Movement processes will remain the same, with slightly different terminology.
