DELTA includes a PREA screening tool and workflow. The system scores the assessment and will trigger a victimization or abusiveness review based on the scoring if applicable.

Key Changes?



PREA Assessments will be completed electronically in DELTA, instead of on paper. Historical PREA Assessments and questions will be stored and can be searched in DELTA.



Many fields in the PREA Assessment will be auto-populated from other screens in DELTA. However, the offender record will still have to be reviewed to verify all data is accurate.



The PREA Assessment will have a numerical score in DELTA, as opposed to just Yes/No answers.



The 30-days review will be accomplished by completing a full assessment instrument. The offender will be interviewed again with the same 4 questions.



There will be an action queue dashboard for PREA that will show staff what is due and who the offenders are that need an assessment for Intake, 30 day, and Annual assessments.



The PREA Assessment in DELTA will have 3 options for physical build – Small, Thin, & Frail, instead of small stature that appears to be vulnerable.

What will be the same?



The PREA Assessment questions will remain largely the same.



PREA Assessments will still be conducted as required by the standards at Intake, 30 Days, and Reassessment.
