# Module: Religious Services

## Key Changes?



DELTA will track Offender Diet Card, Emergency, Marriage, and Special Requests. Dropdown menus will show the Request Type, Description, Approval Method, and Status form, and there are fields for comments, reasons for denial, and documentation.



Diets will be tracked centrally in DELTA using a Diet Questionnaire review screen. This screen captures both the offender's and Witness/Chaplain's signatures.



The Religious Diet Report in DELTA will show a list of all approved diets for all active offenders and when the diet was approved. This report can be filtered by facility.



There will be one screen in DELTA to view an offender's religious preference, the history of their religious preferences, and any religious documents.



Chaplains will have the ability to revoke an offender's Religious Diet Card and provide a reason for doing so.

The Religious Affiliation Report showing offenders' religious affiliation within facilities and across IDOC will be run in DELTA.

## What will be the same?



Offenders' religious histories will still be viewable.



There will still be a Religious Summary Screen.
