Key Changes?



On the Visit Registration Screen, staff can view visiting privileges, suspension reasons, whether visitors have been denied multiple times, recent visits, and the visitor list where new visitors can be added. There will also be a Visitation Minor Restriction (VMR) Flag toggle.



Visitor passes will no longer be used. Visitation Officers will have access to computers with DELTA and will be able to retrieve all necessary information.



DELTA will include emergency visits as a special visit type with a 1-day approval turnaround time. The legacy system does not track emergency visits or approvals.



There will be a history of visitors who have been removed from visiting lists and who removed them. The Visitation Administration screen also shows if visitors have been removed multiple times. This information will be useful for intelligence purposes.



DELTA will automatically generate an Offender Notification of Visitor Denial Status form when visitors are denied after arriving at the facility.

What will be the same?



All electronic documents and forms in DELTA can still be printed.



All data in the legacy systems will be available in DELTA.
