
Purpose of All Payer Claims Database

- Large-scale databases that systematically collect health care claims data from a variety of payer sources
- Ind. Code 27-1-44.5
 - Identifying health care needs and informing health care policy
 - Comparing costs between various treatment settings and approaches
 - Providing information to consumers and purchaser of health care
 - Improving the quality and affordability of patient health care and health care coverage

History of All Payer Claims Database

- Senate Bill 5, 2020 Legislative Session
 - Required the IDOI to submit an RFI and an RFP concerning the establishment and operation of an APCD
 - Stated the APCD will receive and contain information on claims paid by insurers, health maintenance organizations, pharmacy benefit managers, and other payers
- House Bill 1402, 2021 Legislative Session
 - Amended the definition of "health payer" to exempt some policies of accident and sickness insurance
 - Established requirements for the development and administration of the APCD
 - Established APCD advisory board and set forth membership requirements.
 - Specified the duties of the advisory board and the executive director
 - Required the establishment of a fee formula for data licensing and claims data collection and release

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National Landscape of All Payer Claims Database

- Federal grant for APCDs
 - Established under the No Surprises Act of the Consolidated Appropriations Act
 - Available to establish an APCD or improve an existing APCD
 - \$2.5 million over a three-year period
 - No regulations or guidance has been issued
- State All Payer Claims Databases Advisory Committee
 - Established under the No Surprises Act of the Consolidated Appropriations Act
 - Advised on standardized reporting format for voluntary reporting and guidance on data collection process
 - Required to submit a report for such recommendations
