

Sites in Opportunity Zones Summary

of

Indiana Brownfields Program Support

(after Tax Cuts and Jobs Act enacted 12-22-2017 through 9-30-2021)

Based on filtering by GIS mapping of Brownfield site locations,¹ there are 810 Indiana Brownfield Program (Program) sites in the 156 Indiana Opportunity Zone (OZ) census tracts. Below summarizes the type of Program support/assistance in OZs.
