Approved Budget: \$70,969

Background

The site is currently occupied by a single story brick building housing an automotive repair shop and an office. Petroleum contaminated soil was discovered in February 2003 during the removal of three (3) underground storage tanks (USTs) and a release was reported to the Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM). Further investigations were conducted in November 2008 and June 2009 but contamination onsite remained un-delineated.

Current Status

The goal for the expenditure of ARRA funds is to complete delineation of the contamination on the subject property and complete remediation in order to achieve a No Further Action (NFA) designation. On September 26, 2011 ten (10) soil and ten (10) groundwater samples were collected in order to fully delineate the soil and groundwater impacts related to site contamination. IDEM is currently awaiting analytical results in order to proceed with the appropriate remediation strategy.
