Clinton Phase I CSO LTCP Projects

The City of Clinton proposes improvements to its wastewater collection system and treatment plant to implement Phase I of the CSO LTCP. The projects were divided into three construction contracts as listed below:

- Floatables control and new flow splitter at plant – consists of a horizontal mechanically-cleaned bar screen for CSO 002 at the plant influent structure; self-cleaning mesh screen for CSO 005; self-cleaning mesh screen for CSO 006; and concrete flow splitter at the plant with adjustable weirs and effluent pipe.
- Partial sewer separation in Basin 008 – consists of new storm sewers in the area of Mulberry and Blackman Streets, including bioretention cells at various locations along the new sewer route.
- Sewer interceptor between CSOs 003 and 005 and from CSO 005 to the plant – consists of a new 21-inch sanitary sewer interceptor; elimination of CSO 003; and elimination of CSO 004.

The bioretention cells are considered to be green under the green infrastructure GPR category. The bioretention cells will collect precipitation from the street, and are considered categorical under 1.2-1.

The total GPR cost is \$45,671. Of this, the construction cost based on bids is \$41,155 and engineering cost is estimated at \$4,516.

Clinton plans on closing an SRF loan in the approximate amount of \$3,200,000 in April 2015.
