ARRA REVIEW OF VETERANS MEMORIAL HIGHWAY RESURFACING, FAYETTE CO, INDIANA

Indiana Inspector General David O. Thomas, after an inspection and review by Special Agent Chuck Coffin, reports as follows:

This report addresses an inspection and evaluation by Special Agent
Chuck Coffin regarding the progress of a project funded by money from the
American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA). The ARRA intends to
provide a stimulus to the United States economy by providing \$787 billion in
program funding and tax credits. Indiana is to receive over \$4 billion in ARRA
funding.

The purpose of this report is to document a physical inspection of a project funded in whole or in part by ARRA funds.

The OIG's enabling statute provides that the OIG is responsible for addressing fraud, waste, abuse and wrongdoing in agencies. IC 4-2-7-2(b). The

OIG is also to review and recommend policies and carry out other activities designed to deter, detect, and eradicate fraud, waste, abuse, mismanagement, and misconduct in state government. IC 4-2-7-3(2).

Based upon these authorities, random ARRA projects were selected from the Invest Indiana website map (http://www.in.gov/gov/countyarra.htm). This website specifies ARRA projects by county.

A physical inspection was then made of the selected project. The inspection was limited to a visual review of the work that had occurred.

In this case, Contract SRS-32245-A was inspected. This was an asphalt resurfacing of Veterans Memorial Highway, Fayette County, Indiana. The location of this project began at SR 121 and ended at SR 1 in Connersville, Fayette County, Indiana. Work on this project appeared to be complete.

In addition to a visual inspection, photographs were taken of the area and are included in Exhibit A, attached hereto.

As the inspection revealed that the work has been completed, this case will be closed.
